



Antelope Ridge Bus Service Information & Guidelines

- Transportation of resident's children to the Douglas School District is a value added service to our residents for no additional charge.
- Families choosing to utilize this service, agree to abide by the Harlow's School Bus Rules and Conduct, and the Antelope Ridge School Bus Rules. - Only verified resident's children are allowed to utilize the bus service. Verification is obtained by completing the Harlow's Transportation Registration Form.. Only children listed as occupants on the current lease will be allowed to utilize the bus service.
- Exceptions to policy may be granted on a case-by-case basis, these must be submitted in writing to the Community Director for review and approval, and will be contingent upon safe bus capacity, as determined by Harlow's. Requests for exceptions are per school year. If you received an exception last year you will still need to submit one this year.
- The Harlow's Transportation Registration Form must be filled out by August 19th or immediately upon move-in for new residents. This will assist with planning and maintaining the safe distribution of passengers.
- Failure to abide by the Harlow's School Bus Rules and Conduct, the Antelope Ridge School Bus Rules, and/or allowing un-verified individuals to ride the buses may result in suspension or discontinuance of bus privileges.
- Antelope Ridge reserves the right to discontinue this service at any time.

Antelope Ridge School Bus Rules

- It is required you and your child(ren) read the Harlow's School Bus Rules and Conduct and Antelope Ridge School Bus Rules.
- If there is any part of the Harlow's School Bus Rules and Conduct that is not understood or if you have any other questions, please call Harlow's School Bus Service, Inc.
- Questions regarding the Antelope Ridge School Bus Rules and School Bus Schedule can be directed to the Leasing Office.
- It is in your best interest to keep these documents for future reference.

- The following rules must be observed at all times:
 - **KINDEGARTEN AND FIRST GRADE STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE AN ESCORT TO AND FROM THE BUS STOP.**
 - When entering the bus, children must have their keychain in plain sight for the bus driver to see. **Bus drivers will not allow any children onto the bus without visual contact of the keychain.** In the AM children will be sent home, in the PM they will get home from school but must report missing keychains right away to the Leasing Office and make arrangements to pay for and pick up a new one.
 - Students are allowed to get on and off the bus at any stop except K-3 students. K-3 students will need a signed note from a parent/guardian to utilize a different stop other than the designated one. Parents are encouraged to supervise students to, from, and while at the bus stop.
 - Students should arrive five (5) minutes prior to scheduled pickup time.
 - Students are responsible for all of their personal items.
 - Be respectful and watch out for traffic. Do not stand on the road. These are busy times of the day, and we want to make sure all children are safe while entering and exiting the bus.
 - Wait quietly and in an orderly manner.
 - Students are expected to respect surrounding property such as parked cars, mailboxes, grass and landscaping while waiting for the bus and are to leave the bus stop location clear of litter. **Residents of Antelope Ridge have the right to report vandalism of personal property to the police, and criminal and legal action may be pursued. Antelope Ridge is not a party to any police reports or criminal or legal prosecution with respect to resident's personal property.**
 - When parking near a bus stop, please avoid blocking nearby driveways.

Antelope Ridge Bus Stop Locations & Times

Morning Schedule: Buses will enter Antelope Ridge at approximately 6:58 am. The route below is what will always be utilized. Rout times are listed below:

Afternoon Schedule: Buses will enter Antelope Ridge at approximately 3:20 pm. The same route listed above will be used in the afternoon. All stops should be finished by 3:50 pm. Afternoon route times are listed below:

All schools release at different times, therefore all buses will leave their school and go straight to Antelope Ridge. Reminder K-3 students are to be escorted by a parent/guardian to and from the bus stop. Harlow's buses will be coming in separately to cut down on the incidents on the buses while waiting for all busses to arrive at the same location to travel to Antelope Ridge. Each bus will leave their respective school and proceed directly to Antelope Ridge.

In the event of a late start (weather) or an early release, please adjust drop off time accordingly.

REMINDER – ONLY ANTELOPE RIDGE CHILDREN LISTED ON THE LEASE, ARE ALLOWED TO RIDE HARLOW'S BUSES.
